Carterton-Witney-Oxford Rail Corridor Study

We have received an email from Cadenza Transport Consulting Ltd. They are looking for feedback from Carterton Town Council with regards to a Carterton-Witney-Oxford Rail Corridor Study – see email below

Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) has recently awarded Cadenza Transport Consulting Ltd (“Cadenza”) a contract (OCC reference I-1873) to investigate the concept of a possible new railway line (see the letter of introduction attached). We started in mid-November 2022 and will run to the end of March 2023. The study follows on from some work produced by the Witney-Oxford Transport Group, which is available online [here](#)

You have been contacted because we understand you represent a group that may have an interest in this project. At this early stage of design, your feedback will influence the development of potential options. We would therefore like you to complete your initial responses in the table contained in sheet 1.0 of the spreadsheet. The spreadsheet asks for your initial reactions to the concept of a railway route, and confirmation of the best primary point of contact for your organisation. We would greatly appreciate it if the form could be completed and returned to me at your earliest convenience or otherwise by Mon 30 January 2023. If you need an alternate format, please let us know.

As we receive details, we will offer to set up a series of short online meetings in mid-February to further understand your organisation’s views. The sooner we can arrange these for mutual convenience, the more opportunity there is to influence potential solutions.

Questions to be answered –

1. To what extent do you agree with the principal of providing a railway route between Carterton – Witney – Eynsham - Oxford
2. What do you see as the primary opportunities that a railway could bring to the area?
3. What concerns do you have (if any) in regard to a new railway link?
4. What part of the route do you have most interest in?
